- This Division, through the Curriculum and Implementation Division and in coordination with the SGOD HR section, will conduct the Upskilling of School Heads on Early Language, Literacy and Numeracy with Focus on the Science of Reading on December 11-15, 2023 at Red Iron Hotel, Calbayog City.
- 2. This activity aims to upskill the school heads to use a knowledge-based pedagogy to become effective reading planners; enhance their skills to provide technical assistance to the Grades 1 to 3 teachers through SLAC; and promote and sustain a culture of reading in schools, and even in communities.
