1. In compliance with DepEd Order No. 010, s. 2025 and DepEd Memorandum No. 035, s. 2025, the Division of Northern Samar reiterates to the field the guidelines for the implementation of the following DepEd Summer Programs that shall be conducted in the schools:

C. Regional Remediation Program This encompasses existing remedial programs implemented by the region to provide targeted support to learners in Key Stage 1. These programs are designed to strengthen learners' skills and competencies, focusing on reading and mathematics, to better support their learning and ensure their successful advancement to the next grade level. 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3. The school heads shall ensure that teachers' participation in the Summer Programs is voluntary. Requirements for the selection of teachers stipulated in DepEd Order No. 10, s. 2025 shall be the basis for the identification of remediation teachers. Teachers are encouraged to participate in the Summer Programs in the exigency of service.
4. Teachers who shall volunteer as Remediation Teachers shall receive the following incentives: Service Credits of 1 day for every 6 hours of actual teaching; allowance of Php 250.00 per day of actual service; and Certificate of Recognition which can be accessed and generated after answering the Online Teachers Survey through a link which will be shared on June 6 and can be accessed from June 6, 2025 to July 6, 2025. Likewise, Division personnel and District heads who render services on weekends or holidays in line with the implementation of the Summer Programs shall also receive Compensatory Time Off.
5. Teachers who shall participate in the Summer Academic Remedial Program need to accomplish the M & E Tool by clicking the link <https://tinyurl.com/DepEd-SARP> and submit them weekly.
