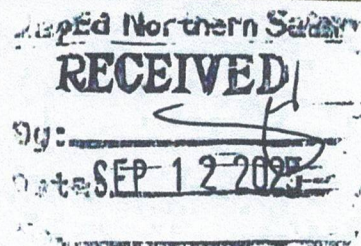



We are hopeful for your favorable response, and we sincerely appreciate your continued support in empowering our youth to become agents of innovation and resilience in their communities.


