(SIIF) FOR KEY STAGES 1 TO 3**

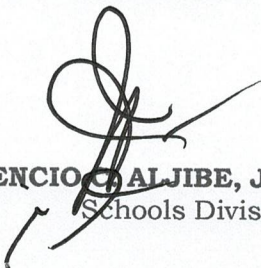

1. In line with DepEd Memorandum No. 073, s. 2025 — titled *Allocation and Release of the School Innovation and Improvement Fund to Eligible Public Schools to Strengthen Decentralization and Accelerate Literacy Interventions*, the Schools Division Office will conduct monitoring of the progress of the implementation of the School Innovation and Improvement Fund (SIIF) by recipient schools on **November 10-14, 2025**. This monitoring is intended to ensure that the allocated funds are being used in accordance with the guidelines outlined in DM 073-s. 2025, to support school initiatives aimed at improving learner performance, promoting innovation, and strengthening decentralization.
2. The purpose of this monitoring is to:
 - a. Verify compliance of recipient schools with the approved Schools Improvement Plan (SIP) and Activities tied to SIIF utilization.
 - b. Check the status of fund release, disbursement, expenditure, and procurement activities related to SIIF.
 - c. Assess the progress of implementation of funded projects/initiatives and their alignment with literacy, numeracy, or other improvement targets.
 - d. Provide technical assistance and identify issues/gaps in implementation that require corrective action.
