1. In line with the Regional Memorandum No. 1046, s. 2015, titled Downloading of Support Fund for the Production and Development of Grades 9 and 10 TLE-FCS Self-Learning Modules (SLMs), this Office, through the Curriculum Implementation Division (CID) will conduct a **Live-in Writeshop on the Development, Finalization and Conformance Review of Grades 9 and 10 TLE-FCS Self-Learning Modules (SLMs)**.   - d. Conduct performance review prior to reproduction and distribution of SLMs.
