1. In reference to DepEd Memorandum OSEC-2025-08 and Regional Memorandum No. 1525, s. 2025, titles Conduct of Schools Division Office (SDO) Managed Trainings on the Alignment of Classroom to National Assessments, this Office through the Schools Governance and Operations Division, through School Management Monitoring and Evaluation, informs the field on the conduct of the **Division-Based Training on the Alignment of Classroom and National Assessments** on **February 20-24, 2026** at **MILKA Hotel, Tacloban City**.
