

 - Be on time and wear the appropriate corporate and/or practice-teaching uniform, whichever is available and practicable, during the scheduled assessment.

Applicants are encouraged **not** to bring heavy and cumbersome instructional or visual aid devices (i.e., overhead projectors, laptops, etc.) and instead find more practical and cost-effective alternatives. Safekeeping of any devices brought within the premises of the Division Office shall be the sole responsibility of the applicant.
