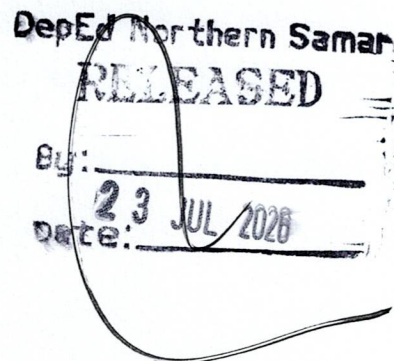

3. These tools are designed to strengthen the implementation of ALS by improving the assessment of learners' competencies, particularly in determining functional literacy levels and identifying appropriate learning interventions.
4. The revised ABL, FLT-EL, and FLT-JHS are specifically intended to assess the reading, writing, and numeracy skills of ALS learners before and after learning interventions.

5. The results shall serve as bases for learner placement, instructional planning, and certification pathways under the ALS Program.
