1. Attached is the Memorandum from the Office of the Assistant Secretary for Public Affairs and External Partnerships dated July 20, 2026, relative to the request of the Far Eastern University (FEU) to conduct school visits, career orientation activities, institutional presentations, and the administration of the Far Eastern University College Admission Test (FEUCAT) in selected public senior high schools within the Region for School Year 2027-2028.

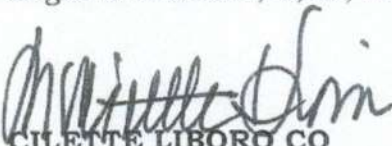

This office respectfully endorses, for your information and appropriate action, the University's proposal to conduct career orientation activities, institutional presentations, and the administration of the Far Eastern University College Admission Test (FEUCAT) in selected public senior high schools within your respective regions for School Year 2027-2028.

The proposed activities aim to provide Grade 12 learners with information on FEU's academic programs, scholarship opportunities, admissions process, and other higher education pathways.

FEU likewise proposes to administer the FEUCAT in identified testing centers and to extend the following benefits to participating schools and qualified learners:

1. Free FEU College Admissions Test to the Top 10% of the graduating batch in schools designated as FEUCAT testing centers and for schools with 50 or more graduating students;
2. Free FEU College Admissions Test to the Top 5% of the graduating batch for schools with less than 50 graduating students;
3. 3,000 academic, athletic and cultural scholarships available;
4. School donation packages through the DepEd's Adopt-A-School Program for Public High School designated as Testing Centers; and
5. Other forms of assistance to senior high schools.



In view thereof, the Offices addressed herewith are requested to:

1. Disseminate this Memorandum to the Schools Division Offices concerned;
2. Coordinate with FEU representatives regarding the proposed schedule of activities in schools within their respective jurisdictions;
3. Ensure that all activities are conducted in accordance with existing DepEd policies, particularly those governing partnerships, career guidance activities, and the conduct of external engagements in public schools;
4. Ensure that participation of schools and learners shall be voluntary and shall not disrupt the delivery of regular classes and other scheduled school activities; and
5. Require FEU representatives to coordinate with the concerned Schools Division Offices and school heads prior to the conduct of any activity.

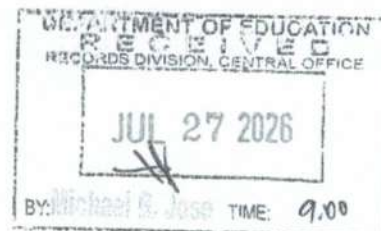
