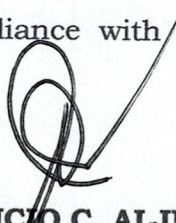

To ensure adequate preparation for the competition, participating schools are authorized to conduct practices, rehearsals, and related preparatory activities after regular class hours on weekdays and on Saturdays, subject to compliance with existing DepEd policies on learner welfare and safety, and parental consent, where applicable.
6. Furthermore, teaching and non-teaching personnel who will render service beyond regular office hours or during weekends in connection with the preparation and implementation of the program may avail of the appropriate Service Credits, Compensatory Time-Off (CTO), or overtime credits. The grant of the Service Credits for teaching personnel and compensatory time-off for non-teaching personnel shall be in accordance with the provisions of CSC and DepEd Joint Circular No. 2, s.2024 and CSC-DBM Circular No. 2, s. 2015 entitled: Policies and Guidelines on Overtime Services & Overtime Pay for Government Employees, respectively.
7. All participating schools are hereby directed to strictly adhere to the prescribed Division timeline to ensure the timely submission, quality assurance, and smooth implementation of the Nestle Wellness Campus Program Competition. School Heads shall ensure the proper dissemination of this Memorandum and compliance with the schedules and requirements stated herein.
8. Expenses relative to the implementation of this shall be charged against School MOOE/Local funds subject to the usual government accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

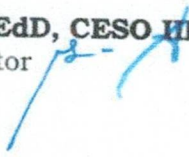
